[Objective of the Dialogue]

It has been nearly nine years since the Fukushima nuclear accident. People were thrown into chaos at the beginning, but they seemed to have regained their calmness gradually. Next year will mark the tenth anniversary of the accident, and there will be attempts to review the history of the decade. But before we meet the anniversary, there shall be a moment for us to reflect our experience of living the disaster and discuss how it has changed. With this aim, we have asked some of Fukushima residents to join the Dialogue and share with us what they experienced and how they perceived the changes during the period. We will also have the opportunity to look back and reflect on recent years by watching together the documentary film “Chernobyl-Fukushima: Living with the Legacy” presented by the Franco-German channel ARTE in 2016 on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the Chernobyl accident. Finally, some of the experts from foreign and international organisations who

have taken part to many dialogue meetings in the past will come to tell us what they have learned from the experience of the Fukushima nuclear accident aftermath and the Dialogue and how they try to utilise this experience in their institutions.
